Biography of Dr. Ronald E. McNair

Dr. Ronald E. McNair was born on October 21, 1950, in Lake City, SC. He received a B.S. in Physics from North Carolina A&T in 1971 and a Ph.D. in Physics from MIT in 1976. Dr. McNair was initiated into Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. at Mu Psi Chapter, North Carolina A&T University on December 4, 1969. During his time in the Houston area, he was an active member of Rho Beta Beta Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.

SPECIAL HONORS: Graduated Magna Cum Laude from North Carolina A&T (1971); named a Presidential Scholar (1967-1971), a Ford Foundation Fellow (1971-1974), a National Fellowship Fund Fellow (1974-1975), a NATO Fellow (1975); Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. Scholar of the Year (1975); Los Angeles Public School System's Service Commendation (1979), Distinguished Alumni Award (1979), National Society of Black Professional Engineers Distinguished National Scientist Award (1979), Friend of Freedom Award (1981), Who's Who Among Black Americans (1980), an AAU Karate Gold Medal (1976), five Regional Black Belt Karate Championships and numerous proclamations and achievement awards. In addition, Dr. McNair was a performing jazz saxophonist.

In January of 1978, Dr. McNair was selected as a NASA astronaut candidate, completed a one-year training evaluation period in 1979 and qualified for assignment as the Mission Specialist on Space Shuttle flight crews. Tragically, Dr. McNair died on January 28, 1986, when the Space Shuttle Challenger exploded after launch from Kennedy Space Center in Florida.

Over the last several years we have awarded over \$100,000 in academic scholarships to high school graduates, who have demonstrated financial need and high academic achievement. Many of our past recipients have matriculated at some of the finest universities and colleges in the nation. Upon graduation they have gone on to hold positions in law, medicine, engineering and many other professions.

The **Essential Friendship Foundation (EFF)** is a non-profit organization located in Houston, Texas. Each year the EEF provides scholarship opportunities, through the **Dr. Ronald E. McNair Memorial Scholarship**, to worthy graduating high school seniors who reside in the Houston metropolitan area.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicant must be a resident of the Greater Houston Metropolitan area
- Applicant must be a graduating senior from a local high school in 2021
- Applicant must have applied to an accredited college/university in the Fall of 2021
- Applicant must be enrolled at an accredited college/university in the Fall of 2021

Application Process:

- Completed **TYPED** application form
- Passport Photo
- Official High School Transcript(s)
- A copy of your Official ACT and/or SAT Scores
- Two (2) letters of recommendations (One academic and one non-academic)
- A short typed double space essay (500 words or less) addressing the following:
 - 1. Why you should receive a Dr. Ronald E. McNair Memorial Scholarship
 - 2. Applicant must be able to attend a scheduled interview (possibly via ZOOM)
 - 3. Provide any additional information which may assist the selection committee

Selection Criteria:

- Overall GPA
- ACT/SAT Scores
- Essay (Content and Quality)
- Interviewing Skills
- Leadership and Extracurricular Activities

Award:

The amount of this scholarship will be determined by the funds allocated by Essential Friendship Foundation, the academic credentials of the applicant, and the applicant's placement in relation to other scholarship applicants. Awards will be conferred to recipients upon proof of enrollment in an accredited college or university.
