MINUTES – A scheduled meeting of Rho Beta Beta Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. was held on Friday November 2, 2018 at 3915 Brookhaven Drive Montgomery, TX. The meeting was called to order at 8:35 p.m. by Bro. Scott Harrell. Prior to the opening prayer Bro. T. Williams lead the passing of the chapter's gavel to Bro. Scott Harrell.

OPENING PRAYER – Bro. Gerald giving the prayer.

ROLL CALL – Roll was called by Bro. McEwen. At roll call a quorum was not established.

FINANCIAL REPORT – Bro. U. Onwudiegwu presented the chapter's budget for FYE 2019. He also gave the financial report. Checks written to the chapter will be mobile deposited that same day moving forward.

BASILEUS REPORT – Bro. S. Harrell stated that we are have been transitioning for the last couple of weeks. We plan to complete the full transition by next week. He participated on a Basileus call. The DR has approved 1 of the 36 MSP request made. A lot has changed with MSP process and Bro. E. Jackson will speak on it tomorrow. 83rd District meeting will be held in Tulsa, OK in 2020. For the 82nd District Meeting the District is asking chapters to sponsor the youth for the District STEM Program where students will build a solar car. Bro. Harrell plans to have the entire EC sit at the front table as one.

NATIONAL/DISTRICT NOTIFICATIONS: Bro. Q. Meads stated that the 9th District Ways and Means Committee is working on the next budget and is looking for ways to invest district funds. They plan on having something prepared by the Winter Council meeting. Bro. H. Burroughs stated that the Friendship Foundation is doing well. Bro K. Shaw is going to be taken the lead for the foundation. They plan on selling the house and using the funds to renovate the fraternity building on Snapfinger.

COMMITTEE REPORTS (Bro. Jason Richards, moderating)

Jason Richards – Stated he is humble to in be the role as Vice Basileus. He plan to put committee chairs in place. He will also be sending out an email on his expectations from committee chairs.

PAC Committee: Bro. H. Burroughs stated that Bro. Antonio Brown is running for 9th DKRS. He is launching a campaign and asking brothers to donate \$100 to his campaign. Please bring it to the December's meeting. Bro. Bert Simmons (currently Nu Phi) has informed brothers that he will be running for DR. OLD BUSINESS:
