NATIONAL/DISTRICT NOTIFICATIONS: Bro. N. Anthony spoke on St. Jude. The chapter has donated over \$1100. Overall the 9th District is leading in donations.

COMMITTEE REPORTS (Bro. Jason Richards, moderating)

NPCH: Bro. B. Mosely stated that \$1200 was donated to March of Dimes. Details of events were in his report.

Talent Hunt: Bro. K. Jackson spoke on Talent Hunt program held on February 23rd at the University of Houston. He thanked everyone that came out. We didn't have any contestants from the chapter at this event. We had students verbally commit but never sent in the application. The Coalition is looking to do this as a Coalition event verse a chapter event. He also spoke on starting at the beginning of the year to get submissions.
